Dear Commissioners,

On behalf of the Jackson Hole Conservation Alliance, we would like to submit brief comments regarding the September 7 special meeting to discuss the Seherr-Thoss gravel operation. Based on our review of documentation regarding this site's current and historical gravel operation, there appears to be a long-standing history of non-compliance. Given the importance of upholding the integrity of our land development regulations (LDRs), this lack of compliance is a significant concern. A case such as this, where enforcement of local regulations is absent, sends the wrong message to the public, including citizens, current operators, and potential applicants. This operation should be held to the standards set forth in the LDRs.

Therefore, we would like to request that you move forward with the actions necessary to remedy this issue of noncompliance.
