We all have a chance next week to constructively add our voices to the development of Wyoming's wolf management plan. Jackson is one of eight Wyoming towns to host this statewide effort to bring the public into the discussion. While many issues involved in wolf management will not be on the table, there are many more that we can discuss that will shape the way wolves are hunted in the Wolf Trophy Game Management Area.

On Wednesday, August 24, from 7 p.m. till 9 p.m., at the Center for the Arts, Wyoming Game and Fish officials will present the revised draft of the plan and allow public comment.
